



Community Involvement & Support

EDF Renewables would establish a local community benefit fund when the wind farm becomes operational.

The fund value would be in line with the recommended Scottish Government rate, which is currently £5,000 per MW installed capacity each year for the lifetime of the wind farm.

The fund would be designed to meet specific local objectives and would be administered locally at arms' length from EDF Renewables in line with Scottish Government guidance.

Community ownership

EDF Renewables supports the principle of community investment in our wind farms. Discussions with local community groups on this will continue.

Community liaison

As part of our public consultation we will be liaising with various stakeholders including local residents and Community Councils.

Supply chain opportunities

If the application is successful, our contracting strategy encourages packages of work on the construction of the wind farm to be made available to local suppliers and contractors.
